KEVIN BENNEAR. Kevin Bennear is a Baritone vocal Soloist with the “President’s Own” United States Marine Band. 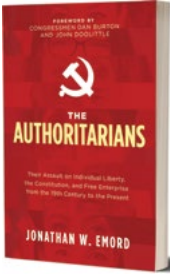

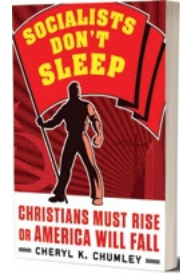

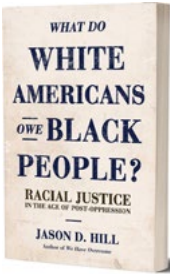
